With the cold temperatures, it is important to make sure everyone is back safely. Make sure you have your cell phone with you...still don't have the office number programmed in your phone? Look at your helmet sticker; you'll find it. Enjoy the warm up this weekend and stay safe.





- 1. Layer up. The lynchpin to your winter camping getup is a close-fitting base layer to trap body heat.
- 2.That brings us to a second winter camping maxim: Stay dry
- 3. Shovels are a must...just in case 4. Cowboy coffee.
- 5.**Embrace Lithium**Use lithium batteries in all your winter electronics.
- 6.Choose the right sleeping bag.
  7.Don't forget the pad...two layers on the bottom are worth one on the top.
  That is, you lose more heat through conductive heat loss when sleeping than anything else, so winter is no time to skimp on your sleeping pad.
- 8. Bring a book
- 9. Boil the snow
- 10. Vaseline...Cover exposed skin in Vaseline or animal fats. Inuit have been doing this for years—simply slather any exposed or potentially exposed skin on your face, ears, neck, wrists, or hands in thick oil and they'll be less prone to windburn and frostbite.
