Spent some of last week and this week grading Trail #3. I'd like to urge all riding members to use extreme caution until you familiarize yourselves with the changes on the trail. The hill descending to the play area has 5 "water diversion" swales, water bars, ditches, bumps...... they are not JUMPS. At the moment each one is marked with an orange safety cone or delineator. They are steep on the uphill side and

angled for water runoff. Hoping to get new markers up in the weeks to come.

Selling Structures?

Are you selling a structure? As you know, the rules still prohibit the sale of an actual site but not a structure. Our database has a special way to help members sell their structures when they decide to vacate a campsite or maybe even upgrade to a bigger structure. Just let the office know your asking price and it will print on the list of available campsites that we hand out to everyone seeking a site. (No personal information, just a member number so we can help them get in touch with you.)

So remember, in addition to posting a flyer at the office and making a post on the forum, you can tell us about any camper, shed or cabin that you hope to sell to another member. This will help get you matched up and facilitate their taking over your site or structure much easier and faster.





Kool-Eggs Add one packet of Kool-Aid to 2/3 cup of water and stir. That's it. I used both lukewarm and cold water and it didn't really make a difference with how our eggs turned out. Keep in mind that Kool-Aid powder is pretty messy, so you should do all of the mixing over your sink to prevent your counter tops from turning different colors the next time you wipe them off. (Not that this happened to me or anything.)To get a nice yellow, use one packet of Lemonade mixed with a quarter to half packet of Orange. To get light pink, use one packet of Pink Lemonade and add a little bit of Cherry or Strawberry. To turn Grape egg into an indigo color, add some Berry Blue to the mix.
