October 3, 2020 - January 18, 2021

**NO RIDING BEFORE 9:00AM,**

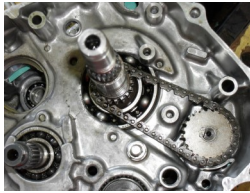


## Tip of the Day

### ALL GUESTS:

**RIDING OR NON-RIDING MUST BE SIGNED IN UPON ARRIVAL.** Any campsite who plans to have **10 or more guests** must email a list of guests names 3 days prior to arrival. Guests not signed in, will have the pleasure of driving home immediately. **THE GUEST WAIVER IS OUTSIDE THE OFFICE 24/7.**

Last time you shut off your quad, everything was working great...but now it won't start. What do you do? First, check the battery. If it's fully charged, move on and check the carburetor. If it's not gummed up and seems to be in working order, check the ignition wire. If that's not the culprit, install a new spark plug and see if it'll fire up. Are you still reading? Okay, if none of those are the reason your machine isn't running, your next step is to delve deeper in to the carburetor. Pull out the pilot jet and look through it— if there's any debris in it, you won't see daylight. If it's gunked up, replace it. Next, check for spark. There may be an unplugged wire in the harness. Finally, if all else fails, check the stator. We suggest running through this list, but if you still can't get your

Dual Sport Events allow riders of street-legal off-road motorcycles the opportunity to enjoy non-competitive trail riding on routes lovingly laid out by dedicated, experienced riding club members. (That's non-competitive, i.e. untimed, except you want to complete the morning loop before lunch is put away, and the afternoon before your spouse calls in the APB.) Participants either follow provided maps and painstakingly prepared route sheets to stay on course, or simply blast around aimlessly ignoring said route sheet as well as thousands of brightly-colored arrows, saving just enough energy to bitch on the social media platform of their choice about how totally lost they got through absolutely no possible fault of their own.
