## Need the Lockbox Combination for the gates?

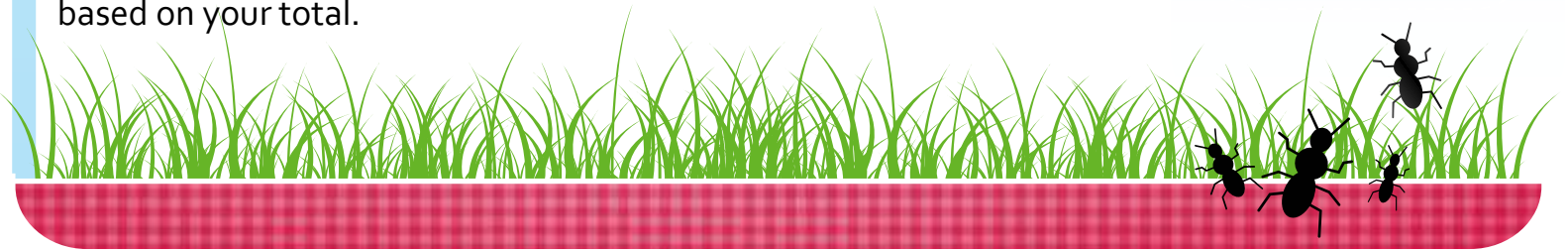
Gate access is currently available to those using the Honda gate. (Honda, Polaris & Valley View campsites)
