

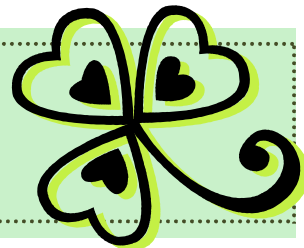

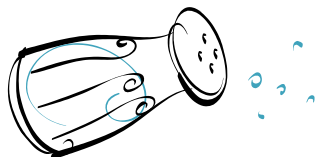


TIP OF THE DAY

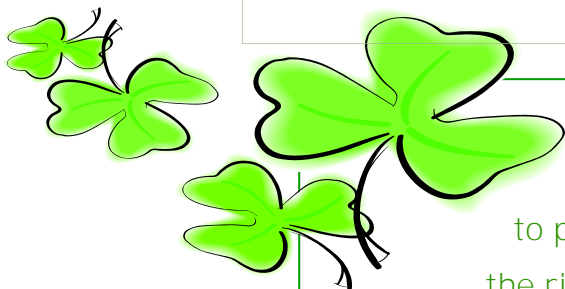
