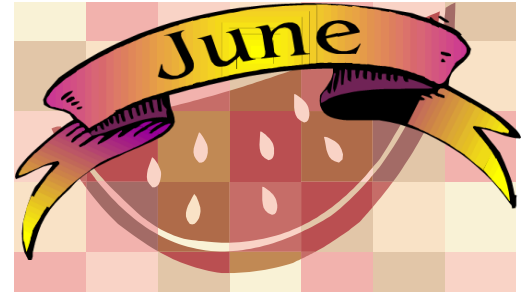
**June 8th:** Saturday Guided Group Ride...meet at the pavilion 10:30am

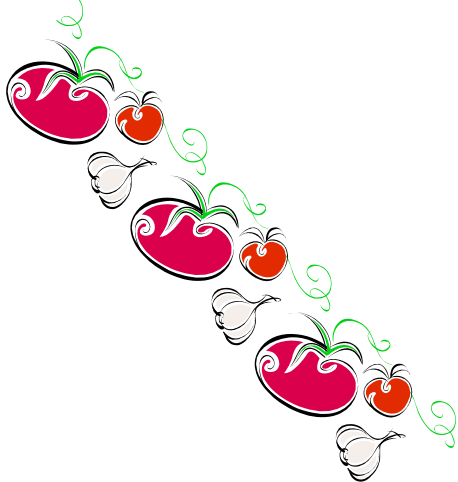
