If you have (or can borrow) a fully street legal dirt bike, then you should check out the RORR Dual Sport which is coming up October 20th.

RORR (Reading Off Road Riders) organizes and manages this event, a non-competitive ride that uses paved public roads to link enough trails to make up a very full day. Morning sections are on Rausch Creek Property, the rest on other private lands that are unavailable for riding any other time.

Rausch Creek has for many years welcomed this event as a means of supporting the sport in general, and building awareness among potential new members. This year Trailriders members can enjoy a direct benefit, as RORR is inviting all of us to join in the fun, at a deep discount no less.
