In an efforts to remark our trails for the upcoming riding season, we will be remarking Trail 9 on the East side of Route 125 due to current pipeline construction. Please use caution in that area until construction is over.

Effective April 1st, 2018: Walters Portable Toilets will take over all aspects of the process. This will include customer accounts, scheduling, billing, and service issues. In order to make this transition, Walters requests that all Rausch Creek customers set up an account with Walters Services by calling Walter's office directly at 1-800-690-5756, no later than April 1st, 2018. With this direct account at Walters Services, customers are required to call before 12pm on Tuesday for service of their unit(s) on that week. This provides the Walters operations team ample time to setup the route for the service technician on the Wednesday service day. If the customer does not contact Walters before noon on Tuesday to arrange service, no service will be provided that week.

Only approved septic tanks can be used; all other tanks being utilized for waste must be properly disposed of immediately. Approved tanks hold no more than 105 gallons, and are only available from The T.S.F Company, www.tuf-jon.com (800) 843-9286
