TIP OF THE DAY

Stink Bugs Ruining Your Spring?

If you see these giant bugs in your home or yard, don't smash them, as you'll quickly find out why they're called STINK bugs. Instead, get a small bucket or bowl of soapy water, and use a garden trowel or wood spoon to knock them into the water to drown. (The soap messes up the surface tension of the water, so they can't escape.) Flush the dead bugs down the toilet or dispose of them in a compost pile. And to keep them from returning, spray down surfaces with a spray bottle filled with water and a few drops of cedar essential oil. Stinks bugs hate the smell, and will go somewhere else.
