Go For A Swim - Cool off after a ride at one of the local swimming holes. Swimmers are welcome,

but soaps, glass and trash are not. Please make sure you clean up after yourselves. Leave nature as it was.

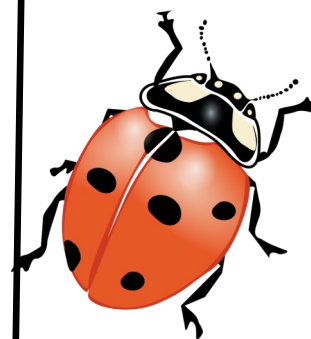
Watch those Children! - Many children come to RCTR to ride with their parents and enjoy the riding/camping experience. Be sure to keep a look-out for any smaller riders.

Campfires - Keep your campfires small and under control so you don't risk catching the mountain on fire. Keep a fire extinguisher or water close by so any stray embers can be put out immediately. NEVER leave a campfire unattended. Pour water over the coals and stir them around so everything is extinguished.

Quiet Time - The quiet time in the campground is 10PM to 7AM. Now that's not just for riding, it's also for generators, loud music and hootin' and hollarin'.
