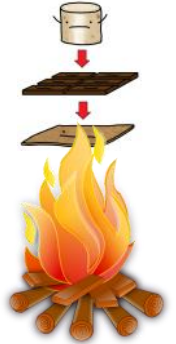
## AUGUST HIGHLIGHTS
