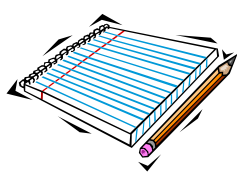

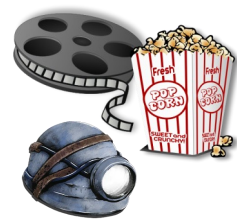

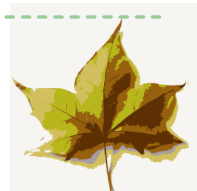

TIP OF THE DAY

Warm Weather Washer Fluid

If you live where it's warm year round or you're making fluid for warmer weather (spring, summer and fall), here are some options for washer fluid.

Option 1:

- Gallon jug
- 4 cups window cleaner
- 1 TB dish soap
- 12 cups distilled water



In the gallon jug, add in the window cleaner and dish soap. Fill the rest with distilled water. Add the cap and gently turn over to mix.

Option 2:

- Gallon jug
 - 8 cups vinegar
 - 8 cups distilled water
- Add both ingredients to the jug and turn to mix. This is a great option because it's environmentally friendly and inexpensive!
