October 2, 2021 - January 17, 2022

NO RIDING BEFORE 9:00AM,

Excluding Most Sundays (except the one listed) & *the Specific Days Below.

NO RIDING UNTIL NOON

- *Saturday, October 2 ~Deer-Archery
- *Saturday, October 16 ~Muzzleloader
- *Sunday, November 28th ~Deer
- *Saturday, December 11 ~Deer-Buck

NO RIDING ALL DAY

- *Thursday, October 21 ~Deer-Junior/Senior
- *Saturday, November 20 ~Black Bear
- *Saturday, November 27 ~Deer-Buck

TIP OF THE DAY

Curveball Crunch

A delicious trail mix your kids can help make.

RECIPE INGREDIENTS:

- 8 cups popped popcorn
- 3 cups miniature pretzels
- 1 cup dry-roasted peanuts
- 2 tbsp. margarine or butter
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1 tbsp. maple syrup



Have your kids measure the popcorn, pretzels, and peanuts into a large mixing bowl. Meanwhile, you can make toffee syrup by melting the margarine or butter in a saucepan over low heat. Use a wooden spoon to stir in the brown sugar. Stir until mixture bubbles. Remove from heat and stir in the syrup. Next, drizzle the toffee syrup onto the popcorn, pretzel, and peanut mixture a little at a time, tossing to coat evenly with syrup. Once the mixture has cooled, quickly separate it into 6 equal portions. Put in plastic sandwich bags, and roll the mixture to form a ball.
