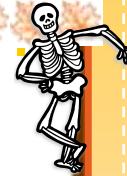

TIP OF THE DAY

LEAVES ARE FALLING

The falling leaves can present an unassuming hazard when many people venture out to see the fall colors.

Be sure to keep your distance from other riders. Also, as the leaves begin to accumulate on the trail, they can be very slick. Whether wet or dry, driving through stacks of leaves can reduce traction making it difficult to stop. A simple reduction of speed and awareness can make all the difference.

- *Saturday, November 20 ~Black Bear
- *Saturday, November 27 ~Deer-Buck

Site Improvements?

Remember, **ANY addition, modification or improvement must be approved by the Office** first to make sure all necessary procedures are followed correctly.

- ✦ Bringing a camper, a shed, or even making improvements and additions to your site without prior approval may result in its removal.
- ✦ Cutting, removing, defacing, or destroying trees is strictly prohibited without notifying the office. Do not hang gas lanterns on trees for fear of causing a fire. If you are tempted in any way to remove a tree please come to the office and get permission.
- ✦ Site modifications or improvements requiring approval also include additions such as carports, deck extensions, deck enclosures, deck additions and awnings.

Most likely, we will agree with you and the whole thing will pass by easily. As long we can keep this place a safe environment we're happy and hopefully you are too!
