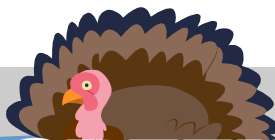

LUNAR ECLIPSE

Will the weather stays clear enough to see the lunar eclipse?

The longest partial lunar eclipse in nearly 600 years will grace the night sky late Thursday, 11/18 night and early Friday, 11/19 morning across the entire country, weather permitting.

According to [NASA](https://www.nasa.gov), the eclipse will be three hours and 28 minutes long, which is the longest partial eclipse of this century and the longest in 580 years.

For U.S. East Coast observers, the partial eclipse begins a little after 2 a.m. Friday, reaching its maximum at 4 in the morning.

You need two large pumpkins and two sturdy sticks. The racers line up on the starting line with the pumpkins turned on their sides. On the signal, the racers use the stick to roll the pumpkins to the finish line. Younger players may want to use their hands instead of the stick. If you want to play this as teams, make it a relay race. This can also be played inside, using small pumpkins.

TIP OF THE DAY

- Sharpen can opener blades by running a piece of waxed paper through the mechanism. It will clean and sharpen in one quick step.
