October 9th will mark the best Dual Sport EVER with a new Adventure Bike loop. If you have a Dual Sport bike this is the event for you!

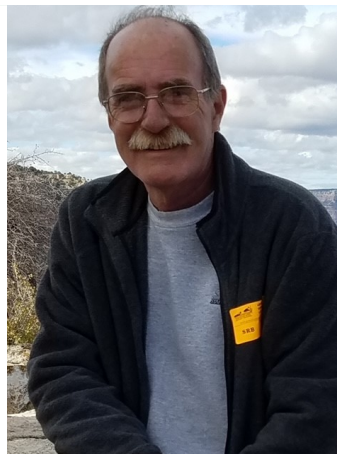
Online registration is now available at rorr.org.
