Dual Sport

What is Dual Sport? Dual Sport is the combination of a street and off-road motorcycle. The Dual Sport motorcycle offers enthusiasts the best of both worlds by exploring trails and still being able to use our local street and highways.



This Sunday, October 9th is the annual Dual Sport held by RORR. If you have a Dual Sport bike this is the event for you!

Online registration is still available at rorr.org or you can sign up the day of. The route will start at the North End Fire Department (118 N Tulpehocken St. (570)345-0733) on Route 125 in Pine Grove and venture its way to RCTR or as they call us the "flat tire oasis." Signup opens at 7am on Sunday, last rider out by 10am. FREE primitive camping available on beautiful level ground field behind the fire company. Join everyone on Saturday in the social quarters! Breakfast and lunch will be provided by the fire company and is included in the your entry fee of only \$25— a special given to RCTR members only so have your helmet sticker on hand to prove your membership for the discount (it would be \$35 pre-entry or \$45 the day of the event if your weren't a member here).

Riders will certainly get a taste of varied terrain at our facility as well as at different off limit trails on other local properties like the infamous Blackwood. There will also be more NEW optional sections that include A & B rated trial, challenging and FUN! Up close views of three century old historic mines, very cool! No need to worry about fuel, it's only 2 blocks away from camp and a short drive when you're on the trail! Plus LIMITED blacktop to and from the trails. What more could you ask for! TIP OF THE DAY

White toothpaste (blue and color streaked toothpaste do not work well), A cloth rag & Water

What To Do: Apply the white toothpaste liberally to your car's headlights. Make sure to cover completely, even if you have to apply a couple of times. Thoroughly scrub using a cloth rag. After scrubbing, rinse with water. That's it! Now you have like-new headlights that look better, brighter, and increase safety and visibility. It's so easy, even your kids can do it. How well does this process work? Try it and see. You've got nothing to lose and only bright lights to gain!

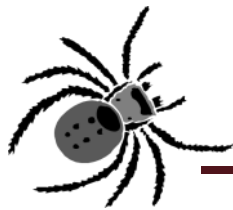
