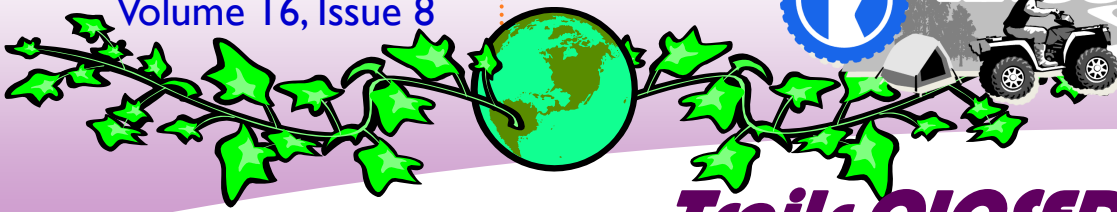

BURN BAN CAUTION STATUS

Due to dry conditions and the red flag warning by NWS, RCTR has enacted the burn ban caution status. Small campfires are permitted only where adequate precaution is taken. DO NOT leave a campfire unattended or it will be extinguished.

Signage will be at each gate as a reminder of the status. **RED means no burning & **YELLOW** means small fires permitted.

TIP OF THE DAY

Most times we can open jars of food with little to no problem, a bit of pressure is applied as we're twisting and then "pop", the seal is broken and the lid comes off with ease. Occasionally though it just won't budge, even after bringing some serious muscle power to the job...so how does one remove them?

Put on rubber or latex gloves so you can grip really well when twisting.

Lightly moisten a dishcloth or towel and use that to grab hold of the lid and twist, this also gives you more gripping power.

DUMPSTER ETIQUETTE

The rules pertaining to what you can toss in your trash can are the same guidelines to follow when using Rausch Creek dumpsters. These rules are in place for environmental reasons as well as local and state regulations related to waste disposal. Our waste management service does not want to climb in our dumpsters every week to find something not within the guidelines. We also request a 2 trash bag limit per campsite. Some have taken full advantage causing an avalanche of trash. Please be courteous of neighbor campsites and stick to the bag limit so everyone can leave their trash here instead of taking it home.

****REMINDER THAT IF YOU PARTICIPATE IN THE SPRING CLEANUP, YOU WILL HAVE A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO GET RID OF JUNK AT YOUR SITE—tires, appliances, furniture, things we don't normally allow. ASK THE OFFICE HOW.**
