Our waste management service does not want to climb in our dumpsters every week to find something not within the guidelines. There is a courtesy two trash bag limit per campsite per week-end. Some have taken full advantage causing an avalanche of trash. Please be courteous of neighbor campsites and stick to the bag limit so everyone can leave their trash here instead of taking it home.

2 bag limit per campsite

No Tires

No HazMat Waste

NO Appliances PERIOD (to whomever put a whole dryer in the dumpster; your suspension shouldn't be a surprise)

NO Electronics

NO Metal
