ALL GUESTS—RIDING OR NOT RIDING, MUST BE SIGNED IN UPON ARRIVAL!

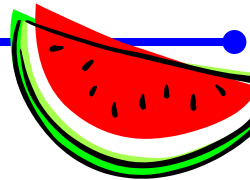

• With the lack of rain, it doesn't take much to kick up a dust cloud...same goes for out on the trails. Keep the dust cloud down on camp road by watching your speed. Allow plenty of space between you and the other rider so the dust can settle and you can see the trail in front of you.

•Keep your fires low & attended.

Trail Etiquette:

• Some basic safety guidelines while out on the trails are: *Stop and stay where you are if you get lost or separated from your group. *Always carry a cell phone and have the RCTR Office phone number programmed in it~570-682-1075.

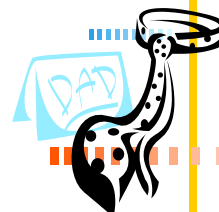

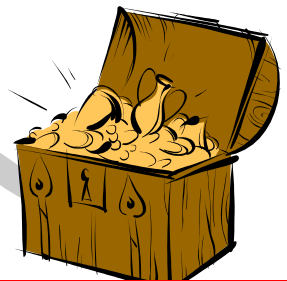


TREASURE HUNT
