## RIDING RESTRICTIONS

Hunting season is here. **NO RIDING TILL NOON Sat 9/30** as archery for deer is open. And we as members need to give the hunters their fair share of the land use. Doing our part to reduce deer auto collisions >>> cause they suck...just ask anyone who has had a deer land on their car.

Each year we work with the local hunting clubs to coordinate the specific dates when the hunters will be out to keep our riders safe.

Hunters and riders, must follow specific guidelines:

- Hunters are not permitted in the campground at all.
- Both hunters and riders must wear a helmet when they're riding.
- Hunters will only be allowed to ride on the land during hunting season, unless they are a member of RCTR.

## TIP OF THE DAY

White toothpaste (blue and color streaked toothpaste do not work well), A cloth rag & Water

After scrubbing, rinse with water. That's it! Now you have like-new headlights that look better, brighter, and increase safety and visibility. It's so easy, even your kids can do it.
