All Guests:

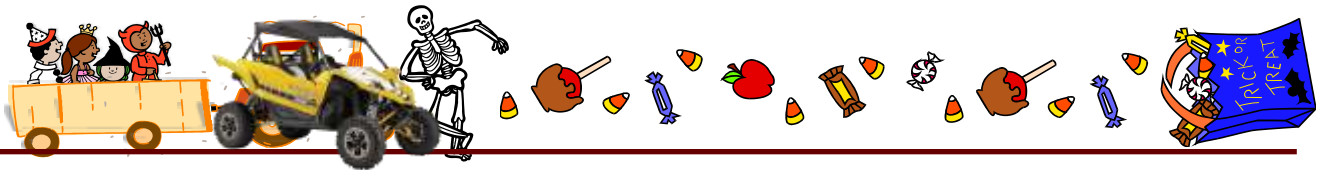
- Riding or Non-Riding must be signed in upon arrival! The guest waiver is on the outside of the office wall 24/7. All members must sign in upon arrival as well!

NO RIDING BEFORE 9:00AM, Excluding Sundays & *the Specific Days Below.

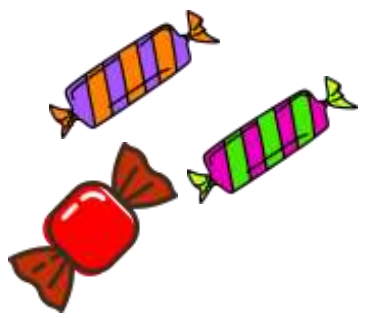
NO RIDING UNTIL NOON
