Super Bowl LVIII is coming up faster than a cornerback chasing down a lineman. It's the culmination of a season in which the defending champions struggled and the NFL offered to much Taylor Swift coverage.

The Super Bowl, however, is never just about the game. Fans tune in for the football as well as the commercials and a host of high-profile musical performances.

In fact, about 22% of Americans are looking forward to Super Bowl commercials. The average cost of a 30-second ad spot during the Super Bowl this year was \$7 million (for the second year in a row), meaning one single second cost more than \$200,000. The most expensive Super Bowl commercial ever was a tie between the Amazon Alexa and Google Assistant commercials during the 2020 Super Bowl. They were both 90 seconds long and cost \$16.8 million each. However, Budweiser has purchased the most Super Bowl commercials in total.

The 2024 Super Bowl, the first to take place in Las Vegas, will feature appearances from Usher, Reba McEntire, and others.

Arguably the biggest televised performance of the year, those watching the 2024 Super Bowl are in for quite a treat. Usher and few select special guest performances will take the stage as the performer of the Super Bowl LVIII halftime show. Reba McEntire will be singing the Star-Spangled Banner. A fitting role for McEntire, as "The Star-Spangled Banner" has played a big role in her career. McEntire sang the national anthem at the 1974 National Finals Rodeo in Oklahoma City. That performance was heard by country singer Red Steagall, who was in the audience and helped finance her first recording, which ultimately led to her first record deal. Post Malone will join McEntire during the pre-game festivities. He will sing "America the Beautiful," part of a three-song run that has opened the game since 2021. Andra Day has been enlisted to sing "Lift Every Voice and Sing," often called the Black National Anthem. The song has been part of the Super Bowl's pre-game telecast since 2021 when Alicia Keys first sang the song at the sporting event.

Here's hoping it's a game worth watching more than the performances and commercials. Happy football to you all.
