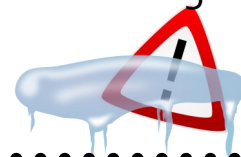

RV OWNERS in the campground.

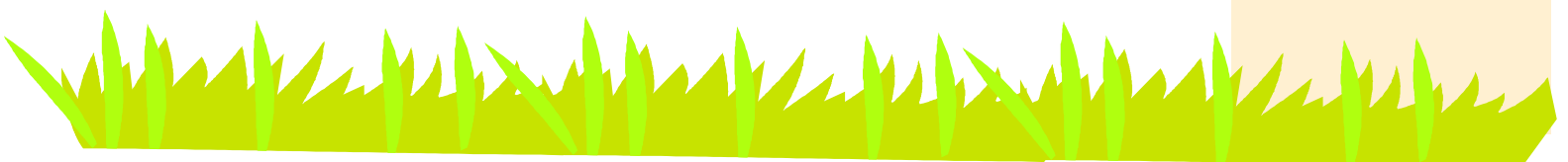
Preferred Portables is seeing a common problem with servicing RV campers. Many are complaining that their RV tanks aren't pumped when in fact they were. Flush the tanks with lots of water when it's time to sign up for service. Using too much water (not a thing)—you'll be happy when you have empty tanks. If there's not enough liquid in the tank the waste will solidify and your RV will not be completely pumped out.
