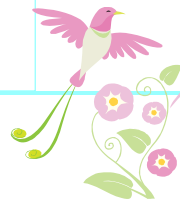

Anna Reeves Jarvis campaigned for a Mothers' Work Day in her home state of West Virginia to reunite families that had been divided between the Union and Confederate sides of the civil war. When Jarvis passed away in 1905, her daughter Anna pursued a national mother's day in honor of her own activist mom. Anna's efforts paid off when in 1914, Mother's Day

was recognized as a national holiday by Presidential proclamation. One of the best way to celebrate Mother's Day is to give your mom the day off. Let her take it easy and relax while the rest of the family does the work.
