#### TIP OF THE DAY

You're baking a cake or cookies and halfway through the recipe you realize you forgot to put the butter out to soften. Instead of heating the butter to try to quickly soften it (which often leads to melting it), heat the sugar for your recipe instead. Place it in the microwave on high for 10 seconds, then stir and heat for another 10 seconds, repeating until warm. Then immediately mix with the butter. It will

heat it just enough to soften.
