Unfortunately, every member that signed up on the septic list last week had a frozen porta-potty and unfortunately campers aren't accessible either. If you do happen to get your potty unfroze before the weather warms up, follow the below steps to avoid this problem in the future.

Pour one cup of the antifreeze into the toilet bowl. Use one cup for every 5 to 6 gallons of water the toilet bowl holds. If it's a flush toilet in

the RV flush the toilet so the antifreeze goes into the holding tank and through the pipes. Pour a half-cup of rock salt into the toilet and flush the crystals down into the tank.
